About 4,500 Protestant churches closed in 2019... with about 3,000 new churches opening, [according to Lifeway Research](#). It was the first time the number of churches in the US had not grown since the evangelical firm started studying the topic... broader trend of Americans turning away from Christianity, researchers say the closures will only have accelerated.
