### Matthew Model...

#### Matthew 18:15-17 NLT

"If another believer sins against you, go privately and point out the offense. If the other person listens and confesses it, you have won that person back. But if you are unsuccessful, take one or two others with you and go back again, so that everything you say may be confirmed by two or three witnesses. If the person still refuses to listen, take your case to the church. Then if he or she won't accept the church's decision, treat that person as a pagan or a corrupt tax collector."

### Three types of Conflict in the church

- There are interpersonal conflicts
  - There are ministry conflicts.
  - There are doctrinal conflicts.

Conflicts can be controversial, stressful, and draining. Whenever there is a conflict, it is essential for Christians to have proper biblical conflict resolution. Conflict resolution needs to be practiced by all people because conflicts cannot be left untreated.

#### Steps...

#### • If it is personally - <u>handled privately</u>

- A Christian is to <u>take one or two</u> other believers and meet.
  - Go before the local church.
  - Removing the negative.

Conflicts must be resolved for relationships, work

environments, and churches to have peace once again. If

conflicts are left unresolved, problems, broken relationships,

and bitterness can grow.
